# *This Too Shall Come To Pass*

“*Shall come to pass*” appears 129 times in the KJV Bible. When God says something one time we should pay very close attention to what he says but when God says something 129 times - **MAKE NO MISTAKE - IT IS IMPORTANT TO ALL OF US !!!**

These scriptures are comparable to many of the experiences you and I have in our everyday lives.

We can draw great blessings and comfort from the statement “*it shall*

*come to pass*”.

If you are experiencing grief or sorrow you can read this statement, “*it shall come to pass*”, and realize “this too (the grief or sorrow) shall come to pass”.

If you are experiencing trouble and trials in your life you can read this statement, “*it shall come to pass*”, and realize “this too (the trouble and trials) shall come to pass”.

If you are experiencing a blessing you can read this statement, “*it shall come to pass*”, and realize “this too (the blessing) shall come to pass”.

It should be our goal to walk by faith and experience going from one blessing to another blessing instead

of going from grief, sorrow, trouble and trials - to - grief, sorrow, trouble and trials.

As you read “*it shall come to pass*” in each of the following verses, think about your troubles or blessings and say, “***this too shall come to pass***”.

Now, make a decision to walk by faith so your next experience will be a blessing to you and everyone around you. But REMEMBER, “***this too shall come to pass***”.

The following verses are the 129 times God says “*shall come to pass*”. I am sure you probably will not read all of them, at one time, so before you stop - please skip to the

## *The Rest of The Story*

When God says “*shall come to pass*” 129 times in the BIBLE we

should realize “*this too* (concerning us) *shall come to pass*”

Just REMEMBER, if things are not going well and you are troubled, “*this too shall come to pass*”!!! If things are great - THANK GOD - and realize “*this too shall come to pass*”! But - **ALWAYS** - keep on walking by **FAITH**!!!

Don't quit, don't ever give up on God or yourself. Remember, God's grace is sufficient no matter the circumstances we may pass through.

As David said in the 23rd Psalm, “The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in

the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies:

thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the Lord for ever." Though I may "lie down in green pastures" or walk "beside the still waters" I must remember, - *this too shall come to pass*. I may find myself walking "through the valley of the shadow of death" but I must remember, - *this too shall*

*come to pass*.

You may say that it is impossible to get through whatever you are facing but I tell you "Jesus said unto him, "If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." (Mark 9:23)

My instructions to you are very simple. Look whatever you are facing right in the eye and say,

**“I BELIEVE  
*this too shall  
come to pass.***
